1. Accounts of Provincial Government to be laid before Council next session.

An Act to provide for Auditing the Accounts of the Province of Title. Auckland.

DE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council therefore, as follows:—

1. A full account of all the receipts and disbursements of the Accounts of Provin-Revenue of the Provincial Government, including the costs, cial Government to be charges, and expenses incidental to the collection, management, next Session. and receipts thereof, shall be laid before the Provincial Council within ten days from the commencement of the next Session.

2. A similar account in continuation of the last preceding Similar accounts every account shall be laid before the said Council within ten days subsequent Session. from the commencement of every subsequent Session.

3. Every such account shall be referred by the said Council Accounts to be referred to a Select Committee thereof.

red to a Select Come mittee.

4. It shall be the duty of such Select Committee to audit, Committee to audit examine, and report upon the said account.

Empowered to call for vouchers & examine witnesses.

5. Such Committee is hereby empowered to call for vouchers and to examine witnesses touching the said account, and every person is hereby required to give such attendance and produce such vouchers and documents as the said Committee shall order and direct by a summons to be signed by the Chairman of the Committee, stating the object for which such person is required to attend, and specifying the vouchers and documents to be produced.

Penalty for refusing

6. Every person without reasonable cause failing to attend as required by such summons, or submit himself to examination, or to produce such vouchers and documents, or prevaricating before any such Select Committee or a quorum thereof, shall forfeit and pay for every such offence any sum not exceeding £100.

Penalty for giving dalse evidence.

7. Every person wilfully and knowingly giving false evidence before any such Committee, or a quorum thereof, shall forfeit and pay for every such offence any sum not exceeding £500.
