## APPROPRIATION ACT, 1868, No. 2.

IN THE THIRTY-FIRST AND THIRTY-SECOND YEARS OF THE REIGN OF HER MAJESTY QUEEN VICTORIA.

> 1868. Session XXIII, No. 2.

An Act to appropriate the Revenue for the half-year ending Title. 31st December, 1868.

BE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:-

- 1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Appropria-Short Title. tion Act, 1868, No. 2."
- 2. Out of the Revenue of the Province of Auckland for Certain sums the year 1868 subject to the appropriation of the Provin-applied to cial Council there may be issued or applied for or towards specified purthe several services specified in the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums of money not exceeding the several sums therein respectively set forth.

Whereas by an Act of the Provincial Legislature of Superintenthe Province of Auckland Session 1 No. 6 1854 it was en. dent's salar acted that "out of the Revenue of the Province of Auck- for the halfland there shall be paid to the Superintendent thereof a 31st Decem-Salary after the rate of eight hundred pounds yearly" And ber, 1868. whereas it is desirable for the half-year ending the 31st day of December 1868 to reduce the amount of such Salary Be it further enacted that the sum payable to the Superintendent for such period shall be three hundred and fifty pounds.
- 4. The Provincial Treasurer or other person having Treasurer or charge of the Public Funds of the Province shall issue and other person in charge of pay from time to time any sum of money not exceeding public funds in the whole the sums respectively specified to such person to ray money

on warrant of and in such portions as the Superintendent for the time being shall by warrants to be granted by him from time to time direct and such Treasurer or other person having charge of the Public Funds of the Province shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such warrants and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sums for which such receipts shall have been given and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his account accordingly.
