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The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the New Zealand Railways Corporation Amendment Act **2010**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act amended

This Act amends the New Zealand Railways Corporation Act 5 1981.

"Minister means the Minister of the Crown who, under the authority of any warrant or with the authority of the Prime Minister, is for the time being responsible for the administration of this Act".
