The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is—
 - (a) Te Ture Whenua Maori Amendment Act (No 3) **2008**;
 - or
 - (b) the Maori Land Amendment Act (No 3) **2008**. 5

- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

- 19 Principal Act amended**
This Part amends Te Ture Whenua Maori Act 1993.
- 20 Trustees may act by majority**
Section 227 is amended by repealing subsection (1A). 5
- 21 Accounts and balance sheet**
Section 276(1) is amended by omitting “incorporaton” and substituting “incorporation”.
- 22 Appointment and duties of auditor**
Section 277 is amended by inserting the following subsection 10
after subsection (1):
“(1A) This section does not apply to a Maori incorporation that had
gross revenue of \$25,000 or less for its most recently com-
pleted financial year, unless the shareholders of that Maori in-
corporation resolve by special resolution that the accounts of 15
the Maori incorporation should be audited under this section.”
