The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is the Crimes Amendment Act 2012.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
- 3 Principal Act amended**
This Act amends the Crimes Act 1961.
- 4 Short title, commencement, etc**
Section 1(3) is amended by,—

- (a) in the item relating to Part 5, omitting “98A” and substituting “98F”; and
- (b) in the item relating to Part 8, omitting “210” and substituting “210A”; and
- (c) in the item relating to Part 9A, omitting “216E” and substituting “216N”; and
- (d) in the item relating to Part 12, omitting “378” and substituting “378F”; and
- (e) in the item relating to Part 14, omitting “412” and substituting “415”.
