The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Climate Change Response (Unit Restriction) Amendment Act 2014.

2 Commencement

This Act is deemed to come into force on 16 May 2014.

3	Principal Act This Act amends the Climate Change Response Act 2002 (the principal Act).

"(3)	Subsection (1) is subject to section 191(1)(c)."	
5	Section 191 amended (Ceasing to be registered as participant in respect of post-1989 forest land)	
(1)	In section 191(1)(b)(ii)(B), after "subsection (4)", insert "; and".	
(2)	After section 191(1)(b), insert:	
	"(c) must, despite section 63, use only New Zealand units to surrender the unit balance that the person is liable to surrender under paragraph (b)."	
(3)	After section 191(1), insert:	
"(1A) The purpose of subsection (1)(c) is to prevent reregistration arbitrage, which was an unintended consequence in the oper- ation of the Act before the commencement of subsection (1)(c) and arose from significant differences between the price of New Zealand units and the price of certain Kyoto units."
