- 1 Title**
This Act is the District Court (District Court Judges) Amendment Act 2019.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date of Royal assent.
- 3 Principal Act**
This Act amends the District Court Act 2016 (the **principal Act**).
