The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Epidemic Preparedness Amendment Act 2010.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act amended

This Act amends the Epidemic Preparedness Act 2006.

4 New section 18 substituted

Sections 17 and 18 are repealed and the following section is substituted:

"18 When immediate modification orders disallowed

An immediate modification order is disallowed if, within 6 sitting days after the day on which it was made, the House of Representatives resolves to disallow it."

5 Disallowance has effect of revocation

Section 19 is amended by omitting "notice of motion to disallow it is agreed to" and substituting "House of Representatives resolves to disallow it".

6 Section 20 repealed

Section 20 is repealed.

7 Notice of resolution to disallow immediate modification order

Section 21(1) is amended by omitting "a resolution disallowing an immediate modification order is agreed to by the House of Representatives" and substituting "the House of Representatives resolves to disallow an immediate modification order".

8 New section 22 substituted

Section 22 is repealed and the following section substituted:

"22 Application of Regulations (Disallowance) Act 1989

An immediate modification order cannot be disallowed under the Regulations (Disallowance) Act 1989."
