The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is the Human Assisted Reproductive Technology Amendment Act 2007.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
- 3 Principal Act amended**
This Act amends the Human Assisted Reproductive Technology Act 2004.

4 Status of surrogacy arrangements and prohibition of commercial surrogacy arrangements

Section 14(2) is amended by omitting “Status of Children Amendment Act 1987” and substituting “Part 2 of the Status of Children Act 1969”.

5 Voluntary register to be maintained by Registrar-General

Section 63(2) is amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (j):

“(ja) the donor’s reasons for donating.”
