The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Medicines Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Medicines Act 1981 is called "the principal Act".

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Regulations relating to practitioners, veterinarians, and registered midwives
