### The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

#### **1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Medicines Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Medicines Act 1981 is called “the principal Act”.

#### **2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

#### **3 Regulations relating to practitioners, veterinarians, and registered midwives**

Section 105A(1)(c) of the principal Act is amended by omitting the word “drugs”, and substituting the word “medicines”.

**4 Regulations relating to designated prescribers**

Section 105B(1)(c) of the principal Act is amended by omitting the word “drugs”, and substituting the word “medicines”.
