The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Misuse of Drugs Amendment Act 2006.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act amended

This Act amends the Misuse of Drugs Amendment Act 1978.

4 Enforcement of fines imposed in High Court

Section 43 is amended by adding, as subsection (2), the following subsection:

- "(2) In this section and section 46, **Registrar**
 - "(a) means any Registrar of the High Court or of the District Court; and
 - "(b) includes any Deputy Registrar."
