## The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

### 1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Palmerston North Reserves Empowering Amendment Act 2003.
- (2) In this Act, the Palmerston North Reserves Empowering Act 1966 is called "the principal Act".

#### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

#### 3 Purpose of this Act '

The purpose of this Act is—

- (a) to vest in the Palmerston North City Council the land described in the Schedule; and
- (b) to enable the Council to sell that land to the Crown for the purposes of a State secondary school.

#### 4 Lands vested in the Council

Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by inserting, after the words "Schedule 1", the words "and Schedule 4".

#### 5 Power of sale

- (1) Section 4A(6) of the principal Act is amended by inserting, after the words "Schedule 3", the words "or in Schedule 4".
- (2) Section 4A of the principal Act is amended by inserting, after subsection (1), the following subsection:
- "(1A) The land described in Schedule 4 may be sold only to the Crown and only for the purposes of a State secondary school."

#### 6 New Schedule 4 added

The principal Act is amended by adding the Schedule 4 set out in the Schedule of this Act.
