### The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**  
This Act is the Reserves Amendment Act 2010.
- 2 Commencement**  
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
- 3 Principal Act amended**  
This Act amends the Reserves Act 1977.
- 4 Licences to occupy reserves temporarily**  
Section 74(4) is amended by omitting “5” and substituting “10”.

**5 Transitional provision for application for licence**

- (1) This section applies to an application made before the commencement of this Act for a licence under section 74 of the principal Act.
- (2) The application must be dealt with—
- (a) as if this Act had not been enacted if, before the commencement of this Act, public notice of the proposed licence was given under section 74(3) of the principal Act:
  - (b) in accordance with the principal Act as amended by this Act in all other cases.
