The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Rates Rebate Amendment Act 2006.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 July 2006.

3 Principal Act amended

This Act amends the Rates Rebate Act 1973.

4 Interpretation

- (1) The definition of **rates** in section 2(1) is amended by—
 - (a) inserting "or uniform annual general charge" after "targeted rate"; and
 - (b) repealing paragraph (a).

(2) The definition of **residential property** in section 2(1) is amended by omitting "rateable" and substituting "rating".
