The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is the Rates Rebate Amendment Act 2006.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on 1 July 2006.
- 3 Principal Act amended**
This Act amends the Rates Rebate Act 1973.
- 4 Interpretation**
 - (1) The definition of **rates** in section 2(1) is amended by—
 - (a) inserting “or uniform annual general charge” after “targeted rate” ; and
 - (b) repealing paragraph (a).

- (2) The definition of **residential property** in section 2(1) is amended by omitting “rateable” and substituting “rating”.
