The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is the Summary Offences Amendment Act 2013.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on 1 July 2013.
- 3 Principal Act**
This Act amends the Summary Offences Act 1981 (the **principal Act**).

4 Section 28 amended (Being found in public place preparing to commit crime)

- (1) In the heading to section 28, replace “**crime**” with “**offence**”.
- (2) In section 28(1), replace “a crime” with “an imprisonable offence”.
- (3) In section 28(3), replace “a crime” with “an imprisonable offence”.
