### **The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

#### **1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Sale of Liquor Act 1989 is called “the principal Act”.

#### **2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

#### **3 Term of office of members of Authority**

- (1) Section 86 of the principal Act is amended by repealing subsection (1), and substituting the following subsections:

- “(1) Except as otherwise provided in this Act, a member of the Licensing Authority holds office for a term stated by the Governor-General on his or her appointment. A member may be reappointed.
- “(1A) Except as provided in subsection (1B), the term stated must be 5 years.
- “(1B) The term stated may be less than 5 years if—
- “(a) at the time of the appointment concerned—
    - “(i) 2 or 3 members hold office; and
    - “(ii) each of them was appointed for a term of 5 years; and
  - “(b) only 1 member is appointed at that time.”
- (2) Subsections (1) and (1B) of section 86 of the principal Act apply to a member of the Licensing Authority holding office immediately before the commencement of this Part as if he or she had been appointed for a term of 5 years.
