An Act to confer Additional Powers on the Corporation of the City of Wellington.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Short Title

This Act may be cited as the Wellington City Empowering Act 1917.

2 Interpretation

In this Act, if not inconsistent with the context,— **City** means the City of Wellington **Council** means the Wellington City Council.

4 Power to maintain private streets and private ways and to light private ways

The Council may maintain and repair such private streets and private ways in the city as it thinks fit, and may light such private ways in the city as it thinks fit.
