An Act to vest certain endowment land in the Waipa District Council freed from the trusts, reservations, and restrictions affecting it and to declare parts of that land to be reserve

Note

1 Short Title

This Act may be cited as the Waipa District Council (Kihikihi Endowment Land) Act 1989.

2 Interpretation

In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, Council means the Waipa District Council.

3 Land freed from endowment

The vesting in the Council as an endowment in aid of Council funds of the land described in Schedules 1 and 2 is hereby cancelled; and the said land is hereby freed and discharged from all express or implied trusts, reservations, and restrictions affecting it immediately before the commencement of this Act.

4 Land vested in Council

The land described in Schedule 1 is hereby vested in the Council for an estate in fee simple.

5 Land vested in Council as reserves

- (1) The land first described in Schedule 2 is hereby vested in the Council as a reserve within the meaning of the Reserves Act 1977, and shall be held by the Council as a recreation reserve under section 17 of that Act.
- (2) The land secondly described in Schedule 2 is hereby vested in the Council as a reserve within the meaning of the Reserves Act 1977, and shall be held by the Council as a local purpose reserve under section 23 of that Act for grazing purposes.
- (3) The land thirdly described in Schedule 2 is hereby vested in the Council as a reserve within the meaning of the Reserves Act 1977, and shall be held by the Council as a local purpose reserve under section 23 of that Act for the purposes of a works depot.
- (4) The land fourthly described in Schedule 2 is hereby vested in the Council as a reserve within the meaning of the Reserves Act 1977, and shall be held by the Council as a local purpose reserve under section 23 of that Act for the purposes of a pound.

(5) The provisions of the Reserves Act 1977 shall apply in respect of the land vested in the Council under this section in the same manner as if the Council had, pursuant to section 14 of that Act, declared the land to be reserves to be held for the various purposes specified in this section.

6 Powers of District Land Registrar

The District Land Registrar for the South Auckland Land Registration District is hereby authorised and directed to make all such entries in that Registrar's register, and do all such other things, as may be necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Act.

1 General

2 Status of reprints

Under section 16D of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989, reprints are presumed to correctly state, as at the date of the reprint, the law enacted by the principal enactment and by the amendments to that enactment. This presumption applies even though editorial changes authorised by section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989 have been made in the reprint.

This presumption may be rebutted by producing the official volumes of statutes or statutory regulations in which the principal enactment and its amendments are contained.

3 How reprints are prepared

number of editorial conventions are followed in the preparation of reprints. For example, the enacting words are not included and provisions that are repealed or revoked are omitted. 4 Changes made under section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989

Section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989 authorises the making of editorial changes in a reprint as set out in sections 17D and 17E of that Act so that, to the extent permitted, the format and style of the reprinted enactment is consistent with current legislative drafting practice. Changes that would alter the effect of the legislation are not permitted. A new format of legislation was introduced on 1 January 2000. Changes to legislative drafting style have also been made since 1997, and are ongoing. To the extent permitted by section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989, all legislation reprinted after 1 January 2000 is in the new format for legislation and reflects current drafting practice at the time of the reprint.

In outline, the editorial changes made in reprints under the authority of section 17C of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989 are set out below, and they have been applied, where relevant, in the preparation of this reprint:

- omission of unnecessary referential words (such as "of this section" and "of this Act")
- typeface and type size (Times Roman, generally in 11.5 point)
- layout of provisions, including:
 - indentation
 - position of section headings (eg, the number and heading now appear above the section)
- format of definitions (eg, the defined term now appears in bold type, without quotation marks)
- format of dates (eg, a date formerly expressed as "the 1st day of January 1999" is now expressed as "1 January 1999")

- position of the date of assent (it now appears on the front page of each Act)
- punctuation (eg, colons are not used after definitions)
- Parts numbered with roman numerals are replaced with arabic numerals, and all cross-references are changed accordingly
- case and appearance of letters and words, including:
 - format of headings (eg, headings where each word formerly appeared with an initial capital letter followed by small capital letters are amended so that the heading appears in bold, with only the first word (and any proper nouns) appearing with an initial capital letter)
 - small capital letters in section and subsection references are now capital letters
- schedules are renumbered (eg, Schedule 1 replaces First Schedule), and all cross-references are changed accordingly
- running heads (the information that appears at the top of each page)
- format of two-column schedules of consequential amendments, and schedules of repeals (eg, they are rearranged into alphabetical order, rather than chronological).
