#### **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 28 October 2022, amend the Anti-Money Laundering and Countering Financing of Terrorism (Prescribed Transactions Reporting) Regulations 2016 (the **principal regulations**) to revoke regulation 3. The effect of this is that the principal regulations will not be revoked at the close of 31 October 2022.
