### **Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force on 1 July 2013 the rest of the Bail Amendment Act 2011 (the **Act**), namely, sections 6, 15, and 16. The Bail Amendment Act 2011 Commencement Order 2011 brought into force on 5 March 2012 sections 4, 5, and 7 to 14 of the Act. No other provision of the Act remains to be brought into force. This order is part of a set of commencement orders related to the Criminal Procedure Act Commencement Order 2013.
