

## **Biosecurity (National American Foulbrood Pest Management Strategy) Amendment Order 2003**

Pursuant to section 68 of the Biosecurity Act 1993, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

### **1 Title**

- (1) This order is the Biosecurity (National American Foulbrood Pest Management Strategy) Amendment Order 2003.
- (2) In this order, the Biosecurity (National American Foulbrood Pest Management Strategy) Order 1998<sup>1</sup> is called “the principal order”.

### **2 Commencement**

This order comes into force on the 28th day after its notification in the *Gazette*.

### **3 Funding of strategy**

Regulation 41 of the principal order is amended by omitting the words “commodity levy paid under the Commodity Levies (Bee Products) Order 1996”, and substituting the words “levy

### **Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, amends the way in which the National American Foulbrood pest management strategy (the strategy) is funded under the Biosecurity (National American Foulbrood Pest Management Strategy) Order 1998 (SR 1998/260).

Until its expiry on 1 December 2002, the Commodity Levies (Bee Products) Order 1996 (SR 1996/350) funded the strategy. The strategy will now be funded by an order made under section 90 of the Biosecurity Act 1993.
