- 1 Title**
This order is the Biosecurity (Notifiable Organisms) Amendment Order 2022.
- 2 Commencement**
This order comes into force on 8 April 2022.

4 Schedule amended

In the Schedule, item relating to organisms primarily affecting horticulture, revoke the item relating to potato mop-top virus.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 8 April 2022, amends the Biosecurity (Notifiable Organisms) Order 2016.

It removes potato mop-top virus from that order's list of notifiable organisms. The effect of this amendment is that the duty to report the presence or possible presence of potato mop-top virus under section 46 of the Biosecurity Act 1993 no longer applies.
