Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force on 1 July 2013 the rest of the Crimes Amendment Act (No 4) 2011 (the **Act**), namely, sections 4(2) and 6. The Crimes Amendment Act (No 4) 2011 Commencement Order 2011 brought into force sections 4(1) and 5 of the Act. No other provision of the Act remains to be brought into force. This order is part of a set of commencement orders related to the Criminal Procedure Act Commencement Order 2013.
