# Regulations

#### 1 Title

These regulations are the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations (No 2) 1991 Amendment Regulations 2010.

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2010.

## 3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations (No 2) 1991.

## 4 International passenger security charges

Regulation 20(1) is amended by omitting "\$15.00" and substituting "\$10.00".

## 5 Domestic passenger security charges

Regulation 20A(1) is amended by omitting "\$4.66" and substituting "\$4.35".

## **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2010, amend the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations (No 2) 1991. The amendments reduce the international passenger security charge from \$15.00 to \$10.00 and reduce the domestic passenger security charge from \$4.66 to \$4.35.
