Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force on 1 July 2013 the rest of the Criminal Procedure Act 2011 (the **Act**), namely sections 3, 4, 6, 9 to 59, 66 to 114, 115(1), 117 to 193, 212 to 244, 246 to 251, 253 to 385, 394 to 406, and 410 to 413 of the **Act**. The Criminal Procedure Act Commencement Order 2011 brought into force on 5 March 2012 sections 5, 7, 8, 60 to 65, 115(2), 116, 194 to 211, 245, 252, 386 to 393, and 407 to 409 of the **Act**. No other provision of the **Act** remains to be brought into force.
