Energy Efficiency (Energy Using Products) Amendment Regulations 2007

1 Title

These regulations are the Energy Efficiency (Energy Using Products) Amendment Regulations 2007.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2007.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Energy Efficiency (Energy Using Products) Regulations 2002.

4 Schedule 2 amended

Schedule 2 is amended by omitting the items relating to Clothes washing machines and Dishwashers and substituting the following items:

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2007, amend the items relating to Clothes washing machines and Dishwashers in Schedule 2 of the Energy Efficiency (Energy Using Products) Regulations 2002.

The amendments update the mandatory energy performance labelling requirements for these product classes to incorporate matters in relation to the energy use of standby functions of the products.
