This notice amends the Fisheries (Total Allowable Catch, Total Allowable Commercial Catch, and Deemed Value Rates) Notice 2015 (the **principal notice**).

The amendments commence on 31 March 2023 but apply on and from the first day of the fishing year starting on 1 April 2023.

This notice amends Schedule 1 of the principal notice to change the total allowable catch and total allowable commercial catch for certain rock lobster and scallop stocks for the April 2023 fishing year.
