

## **Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2002**

Pursuant to section 297 of the Fisheries Act 1996, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

#### **1 Title**

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2002.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 2001<sup>1</sup> are called “the principal regulations”.

#### **2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 11 July 2002.

#### **3 Conditions applying to skipjack tuna purse seiners**

Regulation 27 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, before subclause (1), the following subclause:

“(1AA) This regulation and regulation 28 apply to foreign-owned New Zealand fishing vessels that are used as skipjack tuna purse seiners.”

### **Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 11 July 2002, amend the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations (SR 2001/253) by clarifying that the additional conditions set out in regulations 27 and 28 of those regulations apply only to foreign-owned New Zealand fishing vessels that are used as skipjack tuna purse seiners.
