Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 31 March 2008, amends the Fisheries (Rock Lobster Total Allowable Catches) Notice 1999. The amendments increase the total allowable catch for spiny rock lobster for—

- the Otago quota management area from 140.200 to 143.880 tonnes; and
- the Southern quota management area from 842.200 to 1053.000 tonnes.
