#### 1 Title

r 1

These regulations are the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2008.

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 October 2008.

#### **3** Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Regulations 2001.

- (3) Schedule 1 is amended by adding the item set out in Part 3 of the Schedule of these regulations under the heading "Fisheries (Challenger Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 (SR 1986/224)".
- (4) Schedule 1 is amended by inserting the item set out in Part 4 of the Schedule of these regulations after the item relating to regulation 6E under the heading "Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 (SR 1986/225)".

### **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 2008, amend the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Regulations 2001.

The regulations amend Schedule 1 of the principal regulations by providing infringement offences and penalties for requirements under—

- the Fisheries (Challenger Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 in relation to blue cod; and
- the Fisheries (Challenger Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 and the Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 in relation to the use of a set net in certain waters, other than a flat fish set net during a specified period.
