Notice

1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Lyttelton Harbour/Whakaraupō Mātaimai Reserve and Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki) Notice 2017.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Notification of mātaimai reserve

- (1) This notice applies to Lyttelton Harbour/Whakaraupō Mātaimai Reserve, in the inner part of Lyttelton Harbour/Whakaraupō, that is declared by the Fisheries (Declaration of Lyttelton Harbour/Whakaraupō Mātaimai Reserve) Notice 2017.
- (2) The declaration of the mātaimai reserve takes effect on the commencement of this notice.

4 Appointments

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

The notice relates to Lyttelton Harbour/Whakaraupō Mātaitai Reserve, which is in the inner part of Lyttelton Harbour/Whakaraupō. The tangata whenua of the area that includes the mātaimai reserve are represented by Te Hapū o Ngāti Wheke (Rāpaki) Rūnanga.

Notice is given of the declaration of the mātaimai reserve and the appointment of 4 Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the mātaimai reserve. The Minister for Primary Industries made the appointments at the request of Te Hapū o Ngāti Wheke (Rāpaki) Rūnanga.

The powers of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki are set out in the regulations.
