## 1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for Area/Rohe Moana of Te Rūnanga o Koukourārata) Notice 2019.

## 2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 1 November 2019.

### 3 Revocation of this notice

This notice is revoked at the end of 8 September 2024.

## 4 Customary food gathering area/rohe moana

This notice applies to the customary food gathering area/rohe moana defined by clause 2(c) of the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Notice (No. 8) 1999 (*Gazette* 1999, p 365), which is an area on Banks Peninsula from Koukourārata to Pōhatu Pā (Flea Bay), and including Koukourārata Harbour.

### 5 New appointment

(1) The Minister of Fisheries has appointed Matiu Payne as a Tangata Tiaki/ Kaitiaki for the area/rohe moana.

## **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on 1 November 2019 and revokes itself at the end of 8 September 2024.

The notice relates to a customary food gathering area/rohe moana of the tangata whenua represented by Te Rūnanga o Koukourārata. The area/rohe moana is an area on Banks Peninsula from Koukourārata to Pōhatu Pā (Flea Bay), and including Koukourārata Harbour.

Notice is given of the appointment of a new Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the area/rohe moana. The Minister of Fisheries made the appointment at the request of Te Rūnanga o Koukourārata.

The powers of Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki are set out in the regulations.
