- 1 Title**
These rules are the Family Proceedings Amendment Rules 2013.
- 2 Commencement**
These rules come into force on 1 July 2013.
- 3 Principal rules**
These rules amend the Family Proceedings Rules 1981 (the **principal rules**).

In rule 74(8), replace “the provisions of sections 57 and 58 of the Summary Proceedings Act 1957, as far as they are” with “section 39 of the Bail Act 2000, as far as it is”.
