Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Financial Service Providers (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2017.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 July 2017.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Financial Service Providers (Fees) Regulations 2010 (the **principal regulations**).

4 Regulation 4 amended (Application fee)

In regulation 4, replace "\$350" with "\$345".

5 Regulation 5 amended (Annual confirmation fee)

In regulation 5, replace "\$60" with "\$86.25".

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 2017, amend the Financial Service Providers (Fees) Regulations 2010. The regulations reduce the application fee for registration as a financial service provider from \$350 to \$345. The regulations increase the fee payable in respect of the annual confirmation of a registered financial service provider's details from \$60 to \$86.25.

Regulatory impact statement
