Order

1 Title

This order is the Fisheries (Waka-te-hāua Taiāpure) Order 2023.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 3 August 2023.

3 Waka-te-hāua taiāpure constituted

The New Zealand fisheries waters (being estuarine or littoral coastal waters) described in the Schedule are a taiāpure-local fishery.

Schedule

Waka-te-hāua taiāpure

cl 3

All the New Zealand fisheries waters (being estuarine or littoral coastal waters) enclosed within a line—

- (a) starting at a point near the mean high-water mark at 34°40.200'S and 172°53.230'E (to the south of an unnamed stream); then
- (b) proceeding in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to a point offshore at 34°40.823'S and 172°52.176'E; then
- (c) proceeding in a straight line in a southerly direction to a point offshore at 34°41.820'S and 172°52.320'E; then
- (d) proceeding in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to a point offshore at 34°42.780'S and 172°53.690'E; then
- (e) proceeding in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to a point on the mean high-water mark at 34°42.100'S and 172°54.790'E (near Te Ārai Scenic Reserve); then
- (f) proceeding in a line in a generally north-westerly direction along the mean high-water mark to the starting point specified in paragraph (a).

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 3 August 2023, constitutes the Waka-te-hāua taiāpure under Part 9 of the Fisheries Act 1996 over an area of fisheries water surrounding Wakatehāua Island, Te Oneroa-a-Tōhē / Ninety Mile Beach.
