- (1) These rules are the Keno Amendment Rules 2004.
- (2) In these rules, the Keno Rules 1994¹ are called “the principal rules”.

These rules come into force on 10 May 2004.

Rule 9 of the principal rules is amended by omitting the word “consecutive” wherever it appears.

Explanatory note

These rules, which come into force on 10 May 2004, amend rule 9 of the Keno Rules 1994 to provide that multi draw selections no longer need to relate to consecutive games.
