Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act (Legal Complaints Review Officer) Form and Fee Amendment Regulations 2024.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 July 2024.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act (Legal Complaints Review Officer) Form and Fee Regulations 2008.

4 Regulation 4 amended (Fee for application for review)

In regulation 4, replace “\$50” with “\$65”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 2024, amend the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act (Legal Complaints Review Officer) Form and Fee Regulations 2008. They increase, from \$50 to \$65 (including goods and services tax), the fee payable under section 198(c) of the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act 2006 for an application to the Legal Complaints Review Officer for a review of a determination, requirement, order, or direction of a Standards Committee.

The fee is being adjusted to reflect increases in the New Zealand Consumers Price Index since the fee was last updated.

Regulatory impact statement
