## **Regulations**

### **1 Title**

These regulations are the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act (Lawyers: King's Counsel) Amendment Regulations 2024.

### **2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 14 June 2024.

**3 Principal regulations**

These regulations amend the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act (Lawyers: King's Counsel) Regulations 2012.

**4 Regulation 7 amended (Application fee)**

In regulation 7, replace “\$500” with “\$108.70 (exclusive of goods and services tax)”.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 14 June 2024, amend the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act (Lawyers: King's Counsel) Regulations 2012 to reduce the application fee for appointment as a King's Counsel from \$500 (inclusive of goods and services tax) to \$108.70 (exclusive of goods and services tax).
