



Maori Land Court District Order 1981

Order in Council

At the Government House at Wellington this 13th day of July 1981

Present:

His Excellency the Governor-General in Council

Pursuant to section 23 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

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Order

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- (1) This order may be cited as the Maori Land Court District Order 1981.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after its publication in the *Gazette*.

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The Aotea Maori Land Court District, the Ikaroa Maori Land Court District, and the South Island Maori Land Court District, as constituted by Order in

Council made on the 7th day of July 1969 and published in the *Gazette* of the 17th day of July 1969, at page 1309, are hereby abolished, and the said order is hereby revoked to the extent that it constituted those districts.

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- (1) That part of New Zealand that hitherto was divided into the districts referred to in paragraph 2 of this order is hereby divided into the Maori Land Court Districts referred to in the Schedule to this order.
- (2) The name of each Maori Land Court District constituted by this order shall be the name appearing in the Schedule to this order at the head of the description of that district.

Schedule Maori Land Court District

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Aotea Maori Land Court District

All that area in the South Auckland, Taranaki and Wellington Land Districts bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the mouth of the Mokau River and proceeding easterly generally up the middle of that river to a point in line with the southern boundary of part Lot 5, D.P. 3836, in Block III, Mokau Survey District; thence easterly generally to and along that boundary, the western, southern and eastern boundaries of Section 11, the eastern boundary of Section 10, the eastern boundary of Section 9 (scenic reserve), all of Block III, Mokau Survey District, and its production to the middle of the Mokau River; thence up the middle of that river, to and up the middle of the Panirau Stream to the western boundary of Aria Survey District; thence northerly generally along that boundary, to and along the southern and eastern boundaries of part Section 11, Block V, Aria Survey District, to the southern boundary of Section 2, Block V, aforesaid; thence easterly generally along the southern boundaries of the said Section 2, part Lot 1, D.P. Block 8793, the western and southern boundaries of Section 8, Block V, aforesaid to the western side of Waitehena Road; thence northerly along the western side of that road to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 15, Block VI, Aria Survey District; thence easterly generally to and along that boundary, the southern boundary of Section 6, Block VI, aforesaid, to and along the western and southern boundaries of part Section 9, Block VI, Aria Survey District, to the Puketawai Trig. Station, thence easterly generally along the southern and eastern boundaries of Block VI, to and along the northern boundaries of Blocks VII and VIII, Aria Survey District, to the southern boundary of Section 7, Block IV, aforesaid; thence easterly generally along the southern boundary of the said Section 7, the southern and eastern boundaries of Section 8, Block IV, and the southern boundary of Section 6, Block IV, Aria Survey District, to its easternmost corner; thence easterly generally along the generally southern boundaries of Blocks I, II and III, Tangitu Survey District, to the middle of the Ongarue River; thence northerly generally up the middle of that river, to a point in line with the southwestern boundary of Rangitoto Tuhua 77B1B2C2A Block, Block III, Tangitu Survey District; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and its production to the middle of the North Island Main Trunk Railway; thence northerly along the middle of that railway to a point in line with the original northern boundary of part Rangitoto Tuhua 78B2K Block; thence easterly generally to and along that boundary, the generally northern boundaries of parts Rangitoto Tuhua 78B2E, 78B2D, 78B2H Blocks, part Whenuatupu No. 3, Whenuatupu No. 2 and 1 Blocks, and Rangitoto Tuhua 78B2A1 Block, to and along the western boundary of Section 1, Block III, Pahi Survey District, the western and northern boundaries of Sub. 1 of Section 2, Block III, aforesaid, to and northerly along the western boundary of Rangitoto Tuhua 37B1 and part Rangitoto Tuhua 37B5 Blocks, to and along the northern boundaries of the said

part Rangitoto Tuhua 37B5 and Rangitoto Tuhua 37B No. 4 and 3 Blocks, to the easternmost corner of Section 1, Block II, Ongarue Survey District, thence southerly along the western boundary of the former Rangitoto Tuhua 36A1B2A2 Block as shown on M.L. 14216, thence easterly along the northern boundaries of the former Rangitoto Tuhua 36A1B2B1, 36A1B2B2A and 36A1B2B2B Blocks as shown on M.L. 14900, thence southerly along the eastern boundary of the former Rangitoto Tuhua 36A1B2B2B Block as shown on M.L. 14900 to Trig. 1394, Pukemako, thence generally south-easterly along a right line to Trig. 1551, Ketemaringa, thence generally southerly along a right line to the north-eastern corner of Rangitoto Tuhua part 10 Block, thence generally southerly along the generally eastern boundaries of Rangitoto Tuhua part 10, 51, 21A, 21B1C, 21B1A, 67D and part 67B1 Blocks, to the western end of Hauhungaroa part 8D Block, thence generally easterly along the northern boundaries of Hauhungaroa part 8D, part 8 (roadway), another part 8D, part 8C, part 8B1, part 8A, another part 8C, 9, 2D2, 4, 5, part 2C Blocks, to and generally down the middle of the Oruapuraho Stream crossing S.H. 32 to the western shore of Lake Taupo, thence by right line across that lake to the intersection of the northern boundary of Tauhara South part B Block with the eastern shore, thence along that northern boundary to the western side of S.H. 1, thence along a right line to and along the northern boundaries of another Tauhara South part B Block, Tauhara South part A Block, Lot 4, D.P. S. 11136, Lot 1, D.P. S. 11135 to the west side of Taharua Road, thence along a right line to and along the northern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. S. 9889 to the easternmost corner, thence generally northeasterly to and along the north-western boundaries of part Wharetoto No. 8 and part Wharetoto No. 9 Blocks to the left bank of the Rangitaiki River, thence generally southerly along the left banks of the Rangitaiki River and Tirikahu Stream, to and along the western boundaries of part Lot 2A, D.P. 17646, to the north-east corner of Wharetoto 4 Block, thence to and along the eastern boundaries of Wharetoto 4 Block to the Hawke's Bay Land District boundary; thence south-westerly generally along the north-western boundary of the Hawke's Bay Land District as described in *Gazette*, 1936, page 1808, to the middle of the Manawatu River; thence westerly down the middle of that river to a point in line with the production of the western boundary of Section 1, Block I, Mangahao Survey District; thence south-westerly generally to and along that boundary and its production to the eastern side of North Range Road, to and along that side of North Range Road, the generally south-western boundaries of Lot 3 of Section 26, Block II, Mangahao Survey District, the road forming the north-western boundaries of Sections 2 and 10, Block II, Mangahao Survey District, the eastern side of North Range Road to the northern side of Pahiatua-Aokautere Road, a right line to and along the eastern side of South Range Road, the south-western boundaries of Sections 19 and 13, Block XIX, Mangahao Survey District, the north-western boundaries of Sections 1, 2, and 3, Block VI, Mangahao Survey District, and Section 4, Block V, Mangahao Survey District, and its production to the north-western corner of Section 9, Block IX, Mangahao Survey District, to and along right lines to Trig. Station Marima, to Trig Station AA (Arawaru) and to Trig. Station I (Mount Dundas) on the eastern boundary of Block XII, Waiiopehu Survey District, to and along the summit of the Tararua and Rimutaka

Ranges to the north-eastern boundary of Orongorongo A1, in Block VII, Pencarrow Survey District; thence south-easterly along that boundary and its production to the sea coast; thence westerly and northerly generally along the sea coast to the point of commencement, including Kapiti Island and all other adjacent islands.

Takitimu Maori Land Court District

All that area in the Hawke's Bay and Wellington Land districts bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the mouth of the Mohaka River, and proceeding southerly and westerly generally along the sea coast to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Orongorongo A1, in Block VII, Pencarrow Survey District; thence north-westerly along that boundary and north-easterly generally along the generally south-eastern boundary of the Aotea Maori Land Court District, hereinbefore described to the north-western corner of Umupapamaro Block, in Block I, Tarawera Survey District, on the northern-western boundary of the Hawke's Bay Land District, thence easterly along the northern boundaries of the Hawke's Bay Land District, as described in *Gazette*, 1936, page 1808, to the middle of the Te Hoe River; thence easterly generally down the middle of the Te Hoe River to its confluence with and down the middle of the Mohaka River to the point of commencement, including all adjacent islands.

Te Waipounamu Maori Land Court District

All that area comprising South Island, Stewart Island, Chatham Islands, and all other adjacent islands.
