

Ngā Rohe Moana o Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Porou (Recognition of Customary Marine Title) Amendment Order 2023

Order in Council

At Wellington this 13th day of March 2023

Present:

Her Excellency the Governor-General in Council

This order is made under section 112 of the Ngā Rohe Moana o Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Porou Act 2019—

- (a) on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council; and
- (b) on the recommendation of the Minister for Treaty of Waitangi Negotiations made in accordance with that section.

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Order

1 Title

This order is the Ngā Rohe Moana o Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Porou (Recognition of Customary Marine Title) Amendment Order 2023.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 13 April 2023.

3 Principal order

This order amends the Ngā Rohe Moana o Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Porou (Recognition of Customary Marine Title) Order 2020.

4 Schedule 1 amended

- (1) In Schedule 1, in the cross-heading "Area of Waipapa Stream to Te Wharenao-nao Point", after "Te Wharenaonao Point", insert "(first area)".
- (2) In Schedule 1, after the item relating to the area of Waipapa Stream to Te Wharenaonao Point, insert:

- (b) by a straight line to 37°39′11.87″S and 178°30′08.54″E (seaward of Waipapa Stream); then
- (c) by a line that is at all points 0.25 nautical miles seaward of the landward boundary of ngā rohe moana to 37°40′38.52″S and 178°32′52.13″E (seaward of Te Wharenaonao Point); then
- (d) by a straight line to 37°40′49.72″S and 178°32′39.62″E (landward at Te Wharenaonao Point); then
- (e) by a line along the landward boundary of ngā rohe moana to the starting point (landward at Waipapa Stream).

- (c) by a line that is at all points 3 nautical miles seaward of the landward boundary of ngā rohe mona to 37°50′21.86″S and 178°30′06.29″E (seaward of Ōnepoto); then
- (d) by a straight line to 37°50′32.4″S and 178°26′20.0″E (landward at Ōnepoto); then
- (e) by a line along the landward boundary of ngā rohe moana to the starting point (landward at Waiotautu Stream).

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 13 April 2023, amends the Ngā Rohe Moana o Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Porou (Recognition of Customary Marine Title) Order 2020 (the **principal order**). It recognises 4 additional customary marine title areas in ngā rohe moana o ngā hapū o Ngāti Porou (**ngā rohe moana**) for which the Minister for Treaty

of Waitangi Negotiations has made a determination under section 111 of the Ngā Rohe Moana o Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Porou Act 2019 (the **Act**). The order also corrects the co-ordinates of a point specified in Schedule 5 of the principal order.

Part 3 of the Act sets out the mechanisms that apply to customary marine title areas that are recognised within ngā rohe moana.
