Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 27 July 2023, amends Schedule 4A of the Public Finance Act 1989.

- replacing the reference to Ōtākaro Limited with Rau Paenga Limited to reflect a change in the name of that company; and
- removing Crown Asset Management Limited in recognition of that company's removal from the Companies Office register.
