Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Public Finance (Departmental Guarantees and Indemnities) Amendment Regulations 2010.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Public Finance (Departmental Guarantees and Indemnities) Regulations 2007.

4 Guarantees or indemnities that may be given by departments

Regulation 4 is amended by adding the following paragraph:

- "(f) any guarantee or indemnity contained in the standard terms and conditions for the purchase, licence, or use by the Crown of—
 - "(i) an Internet site:
 - "(ii) software:
 - "(iii) information technology tools, products, or services."

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after their notification in the *Gazette*, amend regulation 4 of the Public Finance (Departmental Guarantees and Indemnities) Regulations 2007.

The effect of the amendment is that government departments may give guarantees or indemnities contained in the standard terms and

conditions for the purchase, licence, or use by departments of Internet sites, software, and information technology tools, products, and services.
