1 Title

This order is the Public Service (Health New Zealand and Māori Health Authority) Order 2021.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 1 September 2021.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 September 2021, inserts the names of Health New Zealand and the Māori Health Authority into Part 2 of Schedule 2 of the Public Service Act 2020, as departmental agencies hosted by the Ministry of Health.

Health New Zealand and the Māori Health Authority are being established to undertake detailed planning, organisational design work, and consultation in relation to the implementation of health and disability system reforms.

The effect of the tick in the fourth column of Part 2 of Schedule 2 of the principal Act as amended by this order is that the chief executives of Health New Zealand and the Māori Health Authority may manage assets and liabilities.
