## **Regulations**

## 1 Title

These regulations are the Resource Management (Stock Exclusion) Amendment Regulations 2022.

## 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 5 January 2023.

### 3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Resource Management (Stock Exclusion) Regulations 2020.

- 4 Regulation 4 amended (Interpretation)
- (1) In regulation 4, revoke the definition of **improved pasture**.
- (2) In regulation 4, insert in its appropriate alphabetical order:

**National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management** means the National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management whose approval under section 52 of the Act was notified in August 2020 (as amended or replaced from time to time)

- (3) In regulation 4, replace the definition of **annual forage crop** with:
  - **annual forage crop** has the meaning given by regulation 3 of the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Freshwater) Regulations 2020
- (4) In regulation 4, replace the definition of **natural wetland** with:

**natural wetland** has the meaning given to **natural inland wetland** in the National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management, except that the exclusion of wetlands in the coastal marine area does not apply

## **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect. These regulations, which come into force on 5 January 2023, amend the Resource Management (Stock Exclusion) Regulations 2020 (the **principal regulations**).

The amendments to the principal regulations correspond to amendments made to the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Freshwater) Regulations 2020 by the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Freshwater) Amendment Regulations 2022 and the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Freshwater) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2022.
