Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Road User Charges (Infringement Offences) Regulations 2012.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 August 2012.

3 Interpretation

- (1) In these regulations, **Act** means the Road User Charges Act 2012
- (2) The brief descriptions of offences given in the second column of Schedule 1 are intended to be only an indication of the content of the provisions to which they relate, and are not intended to be used in the interpretation of the provisions.
- (3) Terms or expressions used and not defined in these regulations but defined in the Act have, in these regulations, the same meaning as they have in the Act.

4 Infringement offences and fees

- (1) A breach of a provision of the Act specified in the first column of Schedule 1 is an infringement offence against the Act for which the infringement fee is,—
 - (a) for an individual, the fee specified in relation to that offence in the third column of Schedule 1:
 - (b) for a body corporate, the fee specified in relation to that offence in the fourth column of Schedule 1.
- (2) An offence against section 10(2) of the Act is an infringement offence against the Act for which the infringement fee is,—

- (a) for an offence involving a light RUC vehicle, \$200:
- (b) for an offence involving a heavy RUC vehicle, the fee specified in the second column of Schedule 2 that relates to the amount of distance by which the distance reading for the vehicle exceeds the maximum reading specified on the distance licence for the vehicle.
