APPROPRIATION.

Preamble.

AN ORDINANCE to Appropriate the Revenue for the Year One thousand eight hundred and forty-seven.

[6th November, 1846.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that such part of the general revenue of New Zealand as is subject to the disposal of the Colonial Government should be from time to time appropriated by authority of the Legislative Council:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Governor of New Zealand, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1. Out of such part of the general revenue as aforesaid there may be issued and applied in manner hereinafter mentioned any sum or sums of money not exceeding the several sums hereinafter specified, that is to say,—

2. And be it enacted that the Colonial Treasurer shall issue and Treasurer to pay pay from time to time any sum or sums of money for the purposes Governor. hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively specified, to such persons and in such portions as the Governor for the time being shall by any order or orders in writing signed by him from time to time direct, and such Treasurer shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders, and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sum or sums for which such receipts shall have been given, and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.

3. For the purposes of this Ordinance the word "Governor" shall Interpretation. be taken to include the Lieutenant-Governor or the Officer Administering the Government of the Colony for the time being.
