An Act to apply certain sums out of the Ordinary Revenue and other Monies to the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two. [7th September 1861.] Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Appropriation Act 1861.” Short Title.

II. Out of the Ordinary Revenue of the Colony for the year ended the 30th day of June 1861 there shall and may be issued and applied towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty in addition to the sum mentioned in the Civil List Act and other Acts for the Service of the said year ended the 30th day of June 1861 the sum of £5086 10s. There shall be applied for the service of the year ended 30th June 1861 the sum of £5086 10s.

III. Out of the Ordinary Revenue of the Colony for the year ending the 30th day of June 1862 there shall and may be issued and applied towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the Service of the year ending the 30th day of June 1862 in addition to the sums mentioned in the Civil List Act and There shall be applied for the service of the year ending 30th June 1862 the sum of £142,336 0s. 6d.

XIII. There shall and may be issued and applied for the Services of the year 1861-2 out of the sum of one hundred and eighty thousand pounds authorised to be raised by the "New Zealand Loan Act 1856" for the purpose of extinguishing the Native Title to land in the Provinces of Auckland Wellington and Taranaki the sum of thirty thousand pounds to be appropriated towards or for the Services hereinafter expressed.

Appropriation Act.

XIV. Any sum or sums of money not exceeding five thousand four hundred and forty-one pounds and five shillings to defray the salaries contingencies surveys and expenses of the Land Purchase Department and any sum or sums of money not exceeding fifteen thousand pounds to defray the costs and charges of Native Lands purchased in the Province of Auckland and any sum or sums of money not exceeding five thousand pounds to defray the costs and charges of Native Lands purchased in the Province of Wellington and any sum or sums not exceeding ten thousand pounds to defray the costs and charges of Native lands purchased in the Province of Taranaki.

£5,441 5s. for salaries Land Purchase Department.

£15,000 for lands in the Province of Auckland.

£50,000 for lands in the Province of Wellington.

£10,000 for lands in the Province of Taranaki.

XV. There may be issued and paid out of the proceeds of any sixth part of the Land Revenue of the Province of Hawke's Bay appropriated by the "Land Revenue Appropriation Act 1858" to defray the costs and charges of Native Lands purchased in the aforesaid Province of Hawke's Bay up to the 30th June 1861 any sum not exceeding three thousand five hundred pounds and the further sum of three thousand pounds to defray the like costs and charges up to the 30th June 1862.

Sums to be paid out of Land Revenue of Province of Hawke's Bay for costs and charges of Native Land Purchases.

XVI. In order to provide means in advance of the receipts of the Ordinary Revenue for defraying the authorised expenditure of the General Government it shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer if thereunto authorised by an Order of the Governor in Council from time to time to borrow and take up money on the security of Treasury Bills carrying interest at a rate not exceeding six per centum per annum and payable out of the Ordinary Revenue at the expiration of a term not exceeding twelve calendar months from the date thereof Provided that the total amount of Principal money owing on the security of such Treasury Bills for the time being in circulation under this Act or the "Appropriation Act 1861 shall not in the aggregate at any time exceed £35,000.

Power to issue Exchequer Bills to the amount of £35,000.

XVII. Until permanent arrangement shall be made for the expenditure incurred by the Native Insurrection and in order to make temporary provision for the purchase of arms and for purposes of local defence generally it shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer if thereunto authorised by an Order of the Governor in Council from time to time to borrow and take up at interest at a rate not exceeding £6 per centum per annum payable out of the Ordinary Revenue sums of money not exceeding in the whole £30,000 on the security of Treasury Bills payable at the expiration of a term not exceeding twelve months from the date thereof. And the said sum of £30,000 shall be appropriated as follows —

XVIII. The Treasurer of New Zealand shall issue and pay the said several sums hereby appropriated to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor by any warrant to be signed by him, shall from time to time order and direct and the payment so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of such Revenues as aforesaid.

Treasurer to be allowed credit for all sums so paid.

XIX. The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum of money paid by him in pursuance of any warrant issued by virtue of this Act and the receipt of the person to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum as shall be therein mentioned.
