## 1884, No. 17.

An Act to amend "The Anatomy Act, 1875." Title. [6th November, 1884.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:--

- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Anatomy Act 1875 short Title. Amendment Act, 1884."
- 2. In addition to the persons specified in section nine of "The Additional persons Anatomy Act, 1875" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), any officer having lawful custodies of police shall be a person having the lawful possession of any body of which he has undertaken the charge in the course of his duty, and the keeper of any asylum or public establishment wherein destitute persons are housed shall be a person having the lawful possession of the body of any person who shall die therein; and in interpreting the said section neither the last clause thereof nor this section shall be deemed to restrict the generality of the first clause thereof.

3. Section fourteen of the said Act shall be read as if the words certificate of inter-"six months" had been originally inserted in the place where the ment when to be transmitted. words "eight weeks" occur therein.
